### Note from Your Pastor

As we close out the fiscal period that runs from July 2024 through June 2025, I thank those who have contributed to help close the gap in our finances. If you have not yet contributed, you may still do so. Contributions can be made by placing them in the collection basket, marked "Balance the Books." You also can contribute online using the QR code that is in the letter you should have received, or you can mail or bring your contribution to the Cathedral Administration Office.

In addition to the funds we receive from this appeal, we have some income that has been delayed in coming in (i.e., government school lunch funds, some of our tuition) that we anticipate receiving in the next couple months. The remaining expenses will be covered by funds we have in reserve.



Parishioners' contributions have flowed steadily these past months, and our parish income was slightly higher than what we budgeted. However, our realized expenses were considerably higher. For the past few years, we have made tremendous efforts to keep up with a fierce labor market. We have done our best with the repairs and maintenance of the buildings and grounds, though the cost of materials, supplies, and contract labor has skyrocketed.

We will put together forward-looking plans for our school and our facilities to best manage our expenses, income, and revenue. We will adjust our budget determining process to make it more accurate and predictive, and we will learn from historical financial trends in our parish to better predict outcomes.

Thank you for your support of our parish. Together, we will continue to make Saint Cecilia a beautiful and impactful parish that brings all to the love of Christ.

## Safe Environment Training

Any adult volunteer or employee who has contact with minors or vulnerable adults in the name of the Church must be Safe Environment Certified. The Certification lasts for 6 years. If you are a staff member or volunteer at Saint Cecilia, you may be required to take a training and have a background check done in order to be certified: Cathedral staff (administration, school, childcare); volunteers (office, school, childcare); school coaches; Mass ushers and sacristans. Contact our coordinator Sheila Graham at 402-551-2313 to determine your status. We are holding a training in the Parish Center Dining Room on Sunday, August 10, Noon to 2:30 pm. Anyone who needs training is welcome to attend.



## Plaza Project Update



The first manifestation of the project on campus is the replacement of our existing disabled access ramp. This two-month process has begun. The south entry to the Cathedral will not be accessible. The north and west entries will still be open. A number of parking spaces in the south parking lot will be taken up by dumpsters and equipment. The north entry has been temporarily converted to become a disabled access entry. Then the existing ramp and steps will be removed and replaced. Concrete and landscape work will extend west of the ramp to where the Plaza will begin.



## Scheduling Mass Intentions

One of the greatest acts of charity is to pray for the living and the dead, and the greatest and most powerful prayer we have is the Mass since the fruits of the Mass are the very fruits of Jesus' redemption. Since Saint Cecilia Parish has many requests for Mass intentions, the following will start being implemented to accommodate them in a reasonable and fair manner. We deeply appreciate everyone's cooperation to ensure that more families are able to request Masses for their loved ones. - · Mass intentions may be requested for a deceased or living person, a family, a special occasion.
- · Mass intentions may be requested for Sundays, most holidays, and weekdays throughout the year.
- · All requests will be honored in the order in which they are received at the Administration Office. You may make your request by calling the office, stopping by the office, emailing, or mailing it to the coordinator.
- Requests will be granted as close to the requested date and time as possible. If it is not possible to comply with the primary request, the next closest date and time will be scheduled.
- · A Mass can be scheduled for an individual once per month.
- · Twelve Mass intentions per individual intention can be set up for a calendar year. Two of those Masses may be scheduled for a Saturday vigil or Sunday morning Mass. The other requests need to be at a weekday Mass.



Masses may only be scheduled 12 months in advance from the date of request. We cannot accept intentions for more than one year in advance because Canon Law requires us to fulfill the intention within a year.

Please note that if a funeral gets scheduled at the time of an intention, you will be notified, and the intention will be rescheduled for the next available opening.

There can only be one intention per Mass time. One Mass every Sunday and holy day must be scheduled for Saint Cecilia parishioners. The typical offering per Mass intention is \$10 that goes to the priest who celebrates the Mass.
